## From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace be with you! As some of you know, during the first five days of 2026, I went with a group of high school Seniors from three high schools in our diocese (McDonell, Regis, and Columbus) to the Seek conference in Columbus, Ohio, put on by the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). This conference is geared for college-age students, but also welcomes high school Seniors and adult parishioners. It was a very positive experience filled with many graces.

There were many good speakers who spoke on topics of our Faith and how to both live out our Faith and to invite others into it ("evangelization"). Some of the main graces that I received during Seek were the beautiful Masses that we celebrated together. On Sunday, the feast of Epiphany, there were 13,000 people, almost 500 priests, and around 30 bishops. It was a small foretaste of what being with God and worshipping Him together in heaven must be like! It was also a reunion of sorts for me. Including the students from my parish, I reconnected with former high school students (many of whom I did not know were going to be at the conference) from all three of my past assignments at a high school chaplain (Columbus, Regis, Aquinas). I also reconnected with some friends whom I knew in high school and who graduated from McDonell and now work in leadership with Focus. I saw priests with whom I went to seminary in Rome and many of whom I have not seen in almost 10 years. Again, perhaps a tiny and imperfect foretaste of the reunion that will take place in heaven, if we persevere with God's grace!

The main grace, however, for me, was receiving from the Lord a deeper clarity about my assignment here in Chippewa Falls. The Lord made it clearer for me that I needed to refocus my time and attention on my relationship with Him, but committing to time in daily prayer, at least an hour each day, spiritual reading, and more healthy habits in my personal life (eating well, getting more sleep, exercise, etc. . .). He reminded me that I won't be able to be a good pastor to the people He is entrusting to me if I am not well, spiritually or otherwise. It was a humbling, but beautiful grace! Praying for all of you that the Lord will continue to guide you by His love and bring greater clarity in your lives this new year! - Fr. Sedlacek


