From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace be with you! As we begin Advent, I encourage you to live this season in your home. There are so many resources out there to help you do this. My main advice for incorporating Advent in your household is: 1) Keep it simple. Maybe it is to pray a decade of the rosary each day before bedtime with the household, or to pray one Hail Mary and light the Advent Wreath each Sunday morning after Mass, or some other practice. 2) Be consistent. Try to incorporate something that is daily or weekly. 3) Begin again. If you fall off the bandwagon, don't abandon your Advent practices, just begin again the next day.

There were a couple of Advent practices that formed me while I was growing up. The Advent Calendar, in various forms. Each of my siblings took turns opening the new window and reading the Scripture verse or eating the hidden candy each day. It helped us to countdown until Christmas day and to prepare our minds for it. Another practice was that, at the dinner table, we had an Advent Wreath. We had a simple ritual each evening at dinnertime that we would follow. We prayed a special Advent prayer after the meal blessing, then one kid would light the correct number of candles, depending on what week of Advent it was. During the days of the "O Antiphons" (Dec. 17- Dec 23), we would add the singing of the verse of "O Come, O Come Emmanuel" that corresponded to the Antiphon of the day. Lastly, we would get a Christmas tree (a REAL one) around Gaudete Sunday (the 3rd Sunday) and, although we would prepare by decorating for Christmas, we would not light up any Christmas lights until Christmas Eve.

These practices formed in me a foundational spiritual disposition of learning how to wait in hope for God's promises to come to fulfillment. I remember feeling what it must have felt like for the people of the Old Testament to wait for the coming of the Savior. Advent is the season that invites us to make time for special prayers and practices that help us enter this spiritual space of waiting in hope for God's action.

This Advent, we are launching a deanery-wide initiative to have 24/7 (aka, "Perpetual") Eucharistic Adoration in the Goldsmith Chapel. The task of having Perpetual Adoration in the Chippewa Valley is no small one. But it is achievable. Eucharistic Adoration also taught me how to persevere through the apparent "silence" of God, with expectant hope that He IS with us... He is Emmanuel. I invite you to consider committing one hour each week to spend time with Jesus and to lift up the whole Church in constant prayer, waiting in joyful hope for His Advent.


