From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace be with you! Next Monday, February 2nd, will be the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, which is also known as "Candlemas." Why? Because at the beginning of this Mass, candles that are used at church and in people's homes are blessed. And so, I invite you to attend Mass at Notre Dame on Monday, Feb. 2 at 8am and to bring some candles from your home to be blessed.

The Gospel for this Sunday recounts Jesus beginning His public ministry after His Baptism and the forty days in the desert. He was going around the towns of the region of Galilee and His message was, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." He then calls Simon Peter, Andrew, James, and John to "Come after Me, and I will make you fishers of men." They left their professions, their way of life, and their families and follow Jesus. They followed Him as He went all about Galilee doing three things: Teaching in the synagogues, proclaiming (preaching) the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every disease and illness.

These first four disciples, or student-followers, of Jesus watched Him, lived life with Him, and learned from Him as He taught, preached, and healed. Then, they started doing the same thing. Every baptized Christian has the same story as these first disciples. Jesus has called us and we have been united to Him through baptism. We are His disciples. We are meant to follow Him, imitate Him, and learn from Him. And then we are meant to do the things that He does. The Church, which is the family of Jesus' disciples, thus carries on Jesus' mission from then to now and until the end of time.

Where are you at in your following of Jesus? Are you just learning how to do that? Are you struggling to do follow Jesus, either in your manner of life or in your understanding of His teachings? Are you beginning to feel like Jesus is sending you out to invite others to follow Him as well? Are you teaching, proclaiming, and healing others like Jesus did? This is "discipleship" – it is following Jesus with others and inviting others to follow Jesus with you. You may have noticed that in our Evangelization Prayer that we have been praying after every Mass that we have been asking God the Holy Spirit to anoint us and send us as "missionary disciples." I intend to unpack what this means in the weeks ahead. – Fr. Sedlacek

THIS & THAT — "I HAVE DECIDED TO FOLLOW JESUS" | In the Gospel reading from Matthew 4: 12-23, Jesus calls his first disciples who were fishermen. Peter, Andrew, James and John dropped everything to follow Jesus. We don't know what prior experience these fishermen had with Jesus. Did they know him? Had they heard Jesus preach? Jesus was a powerful presence to receive such an immediate response as the first disciples gave. Matthew says that Peter and John leave their nets "at once." James and John leave their father Zebedee "immediately." We might be misled to thinking that their decision to follow Jesus was easy, or maybe ill-considered. It seems that the gospel writer Matthew wants to emphasize the sense of urgency that accompanies Jesus' message. It is a message that demands

decision and action. We make decisions and take action in different ways. Some of us tend to act quickly and figure things out as we go along; others are more reflective, trying to figure out the consequences at the start. We need to make sure that we count the costs of being Jesus' disciple, but not let this become an excuse for continually postponing our response to his call. Knowing what you know of Jesus, what are you ready to leave behind in order to follow him and continue his mission? We are called to be followers of Jesus not by preaching, but by the way we live, by telling others what our faith means to us and living accordingly. We can put God first in our family life, too. Let us pray for each other as we make the decision to follow Jesus. Have a blessed week and stay healthy! – Sr. Yvonne
