From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Bulletin Article 2-1-2026

Peace be with you! This past week we celebrated our Catholic Schools. It was a joy to celebrate Mass this past Wednesday at McDonell High School with staff, families, and students from our seven Catholic schools in the Chippewa Falls Deanery. Monday, February 2nd, will be the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. If you are able to come to the 8 AM Mass at Notre Dame, you can bring candles from home that you would like to be blessed.

At Our Lady of the Falls, since Advent we have been praying after Mass our "Evangelization Prayer." In that prayer, we ask God the Holy Spirit to anoint us and to send us as missionary disciples. What does that mean? What are we asking God to do for us?

Being a disciple means to follow Jesus with others. It is making Jesus our teacher and the leader of our lives. Putting Jesus at the center of our lives, that is, letting Him be the Lord. Many of us, including myself, often have something or someone else at the center of our life. Usually, that someone is me. Becoming a disciple is learning from Jesus how to live with Him at the center rather than ourselves. As we learn from Him, we begin to live like Him, interact with others like Him, pray like Him, speak like Him, act like Him, etc...

To be a "missionary" means to live so much like Jesus that we are willing to be sent by Him and to participate in His work of bringing salvation to the whole world. Our Evangelization Prayer mentions three qualities of those who are missionary disciples: Divine intimacy, virtuous friendship, and zeal for souls.

Divine intimacy means being in deep union with God. Jesus is God. In order for us to follow Jesus and then to bring the Gospel to others, our first task is to be rooted in friendship with Jesus. Because the work of evangelization is Jesus' work, in order for us to be effective in sharing the Gospel with others, we must first have a deep friendship with Jesus. Jesus Himself put it this way, "Apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5). How do we grow in union with Jesus? We can do what the Apostles and the first disciples of Jesus did: Prayer, fellowship, the sacraments, and forming our minds according to the teachings of Jesus (see Acts of the Apostles 2:42). There are many ways to form these four "habits" of a missionary disciple. Here are some practical ways to do that: A daily

THIS & THAT — "BEATITUDES AND ST. BRIDGET'S" | Today we begin Jesus' Sermon on the Mount from Matthew's Gospel 5:1-12. The Beatitudes are a way to teach about who will find favor with God. "Blessed" is sometimes translated as "happy," "fortunate" or "favored." Jesus is saying that divine favor is upon those who are poor, those who mourn, those who are persecuted and so on. Jesus' blueprint for happiness reflects little of what the world might call happiness. If we accept the "get ahead" message of our culture today, we will think that having money, being successful, and having possessions would make us blessed. We can see how St. Bridget lived her life in order to find favor with God. Bridget (sometimes called Brigid), became a nun in her youth and worked very hard to better the situation in her country of Ireland. She worked hard at laying the foundation of education which developed into the universities of the Middle Ages. Bridget gave the women in her country the opportunity to use their energies and intellect in a way previously not known to them. She was devoted to the Sign Of The Cross and is often seen

holding a cross woven from rushes. She also helped the poor and the sick in her country. Our ancestors in faith honored her by calling our church St. Bridget's nearly 160+ years ago. On February 1st we celebrate the feast day of St. Bridget at Mass followed by a pancake breakfast in the hall after Mass. Let us together pray for an increase of faith so that we too may be BLESSED.
