## From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Our parishes in the Chippewa area will be going through some change in the months ahead. I am grateful for all your prayers during this time for our priests, staff, and all our parishes.

Perhaps one of the biggest questions at this time is, "Why are we moving to having a single pastor for the five parishes in the Chippewa area with three associate pastors?" I included in last week's bulletin some of Bishop Battersby's reasoning for groupings like this in our diocese: 1) To position our priests to pivot from a maintenance mindset to a "mission-oriented way of being the Church." 2) To help set us up for healthier patterns of ministry for our priests and lay leaders, especially a fuller Sunday Mass experience that fosters more vibrant parish life.

My answer would be the same, but perhaps worded differently. The world has changed since our parishes were first founded. This has always been the case in the life of the Church. We did not organize parish life in our parishes in 1960 like we did in 1870. We do not organize the mission of the parish now like we did in 1990. Nor would it be reasonable for us to do so. While people always need basic spiritual care - access to the sacraments and catechesis - other needs are becoming urgent in our world which is increasingly post-Christian.

I have told some of our more seasoned parishioners (from whom we younger folks could learn a lot of wisdom!) that I struggle to even imagine a world like the one they grew up in, when everyone, more or less, went to church on Sunday, had intact marriages, did not cohabit until they got married, and a host of other social realities which are simply not the norm anymore. There is a deep need for both evangelization, the first telling of the Good News of Jesus Christ, and for healing from the major damage that our post-Christian world has inflicted on many people, including us.

To meet the mission that Jesus is giving us in our current context, working together is better than working separately. We are stronger together. We are seeking to put the mission of evangelization first, and then organizing our resources and efforts around that common mission. This is not "decline management," but a re-grouping effort to set us up for "growth management." More on that to come.
