From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace be with you! A very blessed and merry Christmas to you all! Did you know that the Christmas season begins on Christmas Eve night and lasts until the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which is on Sunday, January 11th this year? So, you can and certainly should continue to wish others a "Merry Christmas" at least until then. It is certainly appropriate and encouraged to leave up your Christmas decorations until that day as well. The mysteries of our Lord's Nativity and Epiphany are too deep to reflect upon for only one day. And it is certainly too wonderful to celebrate for only one day!

During the Advent and Christmas seasons, I often find myself meditating on the "hidden life" of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, the Holy Family, and their life at Nazareth. After all, that is the place where Jesus spent a vast majority of his life on earth, 30 out of about 33 years. What was His life like? What could we expect to see if we were "flies on the wall" in the home of the Holy Family?

From the very brief snippets of Jesus' infancy and childhood that are recorded in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke, we get the sense that it would have been wonderful, and yet also very like our own lives. There were happy times and difficult times. Times of worry about paying bills (and taxes!), business stress with Joseph's carpentry customers, and even the normal annoyances that are inevitable when more than one person dwells under the same roof, though without sin. In the Gospel of Luke, when the "lost" Jesus is found in the Temple, Mary says, "Son, why have you done this to us! Can't you see that your father and I have been searching for you with great anxiety?" And the twelve-year-old Jesus says, "But why were you looking for me?" Then the Gospel writer relates, "And they did not understand what he was saying to them." Even the sinless Mary and the sinless Son of God did not always understand each other.
