Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Please pray for our young people who are receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on this 5th Sunday of Easter at St. Charles. Speaking about prayers, the staff members of all five of the Chippewa area parishes will be taking a day-long retreat offsite on Monday. Because of this, there will not be an 8:00 AM Mass at Notre Dame on Monday, May 4th. The Parish offices will be closed that day. They will be open on Tuesday, May 5th. Please considering praying at home or going to the Goldsmith Adoration Chapel sometime on May 4th to pray for our priests and parish staff members, that they be filled with the graces that God desires to pour out on them! Note: There will be Mass available at 5:30 pm at St. Charles that day.

Another opportunity for prayer is during the week of May 11-15. Many of the priests of our Diocese will be on retreat that week together, including both Fr. Nowicki and I. THIS & THAT — "JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE" | As you read today's Gospel, John 14:1-12, keep in mind that members of the same family share many characteristics, even though each person in the family is an individual. There are physical resemblances and mannerisms that are shared by members of a family and so meeting one of the family, one knows that this person belongs to such and such a family because of the strong resemblance. Jesus tells his disciples about his relationship with the Father. Their relationship is so close that Jesus says that those who have seen and known him have also seen and known the Father. Jesus promises his disciples that because of their faith in him and in the Father, they too will be able to do the work of the Father as Jesus did. Jesus tells the disciples and us that "I AM THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE." Jesus invited the disciples to follow him, but Thomas asks, "How can we know the way?" As we continue to walk together as Our Lady of the Falls Catholic Community, we at times wonder the same thing. But by keeping our eyes fixed on Jesus as THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE, we cannot go astray. Our culture today tells us it doesn't matter what way we follow, but we know that is not true. I am reminded of an old

gospel song that says, "We've come this far by faith, leaning on the Lord, trusting in his holy word, He's never failed us yet." And that's the truth! Have a blessed week and stay healthy. — Sr. Yvonne
