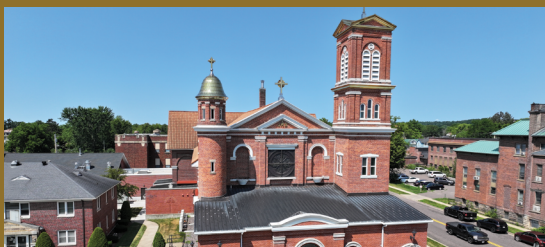

From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace to you! As some of you may know, our Catholic community in the Chippewa area has been advancing a pastoral plan actively for a little over five years now. That five year plan has come to its culminating point now with the assigning of one pastor for all five parishes in a new pastorate, which we are calling "Our Lady of the Falls," in honor of our Blessed Mother, who has been a uniting patroness for the Catholics of this area for 170 years.

We are in a transition time now, adjusting to a different reality of having one pastor (me! Fr. Sedlacek) lead the whole Catholic community of five parishes and our schools (McDonell and St. Peter School). I do have associate priests to assist me and to form with me a "priest team." I am very grateful for Fathers Kren, Welles, and Nowicki. However, we have not had only one pastor leading the parishes of Chippewa Falls since 1884, when St. Charles Borromeo parish was being formed from Notre Dame. Holy Ghost parish came a couple years after and each parish got their own pastor to lead them. The Catholic Church in Chippewa has been in this sort of a situation before, just not within any of our lifetimes!

To help us focus our energy and efforts, with the help of the Parishes Leadership Team, I have formulated an answer to the question, "Why do we (Our Lady of the Falls) exist?" This answer is a sort of "purpose" or "mission" statement that helps guide all of our work, ministries, and efforts in our parishes and schools: *Our Lady of the Falls Catholic Community exists to abide together with Jesus and invite others into His family.* In other words, what is our purpose, as Catholics who live in the Chippewa area? It is to "abide together with Jesus", which means to grow in relationship with the person of Jesus Christ, the God-man, and to do that with others. Our purpose is to become holy, to become saints. We can only do that fully in the context of the Church ("together"). From our living life with Jesus together as His disciples, we are able to "invite others into His family," which is the Church, the Body of Christ. Our purpose is to evangelize, which means to help others to come to know Jesus and to grow into deeper relationship with Him.

It is my hope that we will unite around this purpose and mission. It will help us get out of bed each day, energize our efforts, and focus our planning. We desire to follow Jesus Christ, our true shepherd, who desires not just that we survive or manage decline, but to grow, thrive, and transform the whole world in our portion of God's vineyard, the people of the Chippewa Valley under the intercession and protection of Our Lady of the Falls.

THIS & THAT: "PETER THE ROCK" | Today's gospel from Matthew 16: 13-20 presents Jesus telling Peter to take charge of his church. By the time Matthew wrote his gospel, Peter had been martyred, so if the role Jesus was giving Peter was merely personal, there would have been no reason to make an issue of it as Matthew did.. It was a role to be carried on by Peter's successors. Although Peter and his successors had the primary role to take charge of the Church, the job of carrying on Jesus' ministries was not his alone. Some are ordained for a specific form of leadership, but everyone shares in Christ's work through the Sacrament of Confirmation. We share the work of Jesus, and we pray that we won't let him down. When Jesus asks his disciples the question: "But who do you say that I am?" the question could be directed to all of us. It invites us to answer as Peter did. We might think of Jesus' response as blessing us, naming us disciples, and commissioning us, to announce the Good News. The pope is the keeper of the teachings of the church and a minister. of

God's grace and mercy as well as our Father in faith, our guide, and our example. The papacy is a great gift to the Church, uniting Catholics around the world and down through history. In his teaching the pope fulfills his office of "rock" so that we can journey the faith of the Church with confidence on our way to God's kingdom. We honor and pray for our present Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, and ask God to give him strength, courage, and wisdom to follow in the footsteps of Peter, our first pope. Let us pray for each other and for the Church in the Chippewa Valley. Have a blessed week and stay healthy! — Sr. Yvonne
