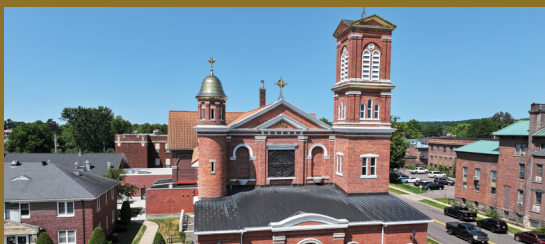

From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace to you! I will be going on a family heritage trip to the Czech Republic this coming week. I will for sure pray for you all at the Shrine of the Infant of Prague and "Holy Mountain," which is a shrine to the Blessed Virgin Mary just south of Prague. Pray for me too!

Our five distinct parishes are working together as one "pastorate," which is a group of parishes led by a single pastor (me!). Some aspects and organizing of our Catholic life will be best served if done on a parish-by-parish basis (bank accounts, etc. . .). Other aspects will be better served if the entire Catholic community works together in a group effort. To help us in

those group efforts, last weekend I wrote about the question, "What do we (Our Lady of the Falls) exist?" *Our Lady of the Falls Catholic Community exists to abide together with Jesus and invite others into His family.*

Another guiding question for our pastorate is "How do we behave?" The answer to this question concerns our core values and our non-negotiable behaviors. These behaviors describe how our Catholic community and those that lead, work for, volunteer for, and belong to it carry out the mission of abiding together with Jesus and inviting others into His family. The Parishes Leadership Team, after much time for prayer, formulated three "behaviors" that describe how our Catholic community carries out the mission entrusted to us: *We are powered by prayer, joyfully generous, and mission-minded.*

Powered by Prayer is our primary and first behavior. In all our works and decisions, we seek the will of God first. We rely on God's grace and the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, rather than our own efforts, control, or wills. And we continuously intercede for our parishes and one another. *Joyfully Generous*: Each member of our community spends themselves for the sake of the Gospel. We give from the overflow from what we receive from God's grace and providence. And we discern how to best use our gifts for the glory of God and the mission Christ has given us. *Mission-Minded*: This behavior means that each of us takes personal ownership and initiative in our Catholic Community, and not just wait for "someone else" to step up. We prioritize people over programs, because the Church is not the buildings, events, meetings, or finances, but the people who are part of Jesus' family. We are willing to adapt to be more effective in our efforts of evangelization (i.e. "invite others into His family").

THIS & THAT: "YOU ARE NOT THINKING AS GOD DOES" | Immediately after Jesus proclaimed Peter the rock upon which he would build his church, Peter reveals the limits of his understanding of Christ. When Jesus announces that he will suffer and be killed, Peter responds in a human way of thinking: the Messiah and the Son of God could not suffer and die. Jesus recognizes this as a temptation to abandon the course and insists that the kingdom of heaven is costly. This is not a new teaching — Jesus has been proclaiming it all along. It is our nature to safeguard those we love. Peter swore to protect Jesus. He was certain. that his friend was not going to die. No buddy of his was ever going to get hurt when he was around. Jesus valued the will of God over Peter's short-lived preservation. Jesus exclaimed: **"You are not thinking as God does."** To die on the cross was something that the Savior had to do, even though it would be agonizing. Spouses die, fiends move, grandmas go to eternity, and we may be tempted to hold our loved ones back, but we cannot save them. To release others is something we must do, even though it is very hard. Who do you try to protect? How much of his/her future can you truly control? We sometimes feel

that the Lord is urging us to do things we would rather avoid. We are torn between playing it safe and following the Lord. To deny oneself, take up one's cross and follow Jesus means more than merely accepting one's lot in life. It means finding the courage to say and do what God is urging us to do — in spite of our fears and the trouble it may cause us. In today's gospel Jesus promises that he will help those who pray to him with our needs. Let us pray for each other! Have a blessed week and stay healthy! — Sr. Yvonne
