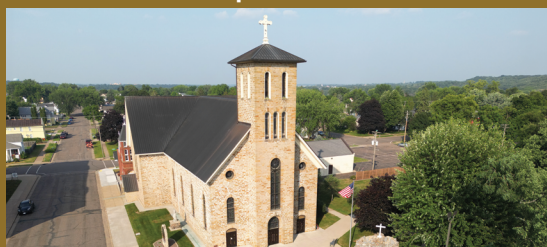

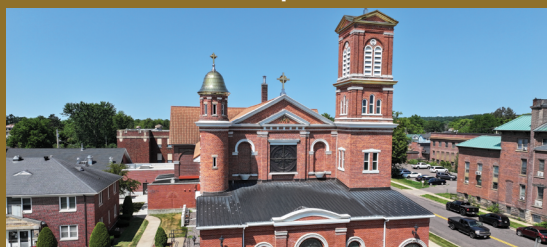

From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace be with you! It has now been one month since our five parishes have joined together into one pastorate (multiple parishes sharing the same pastor). We are very blessed to have four priests serving our parishes.

Just over a year ago, I needed to make an important decision. My 2013 Chevy Impala had reached 259,000 miles. It had undergone a number of minor repairs over the past nine years that I had it. My go-to mechanic said that it could be fine for another 100,000 miles, or the transmission could blow up tomorrow. You just don't know when a car reaches that age and

amount of use.

And so I had to make a decision if I was going to get a newer car or to keep on with the older car. The older car still worked very well, but its remaining days were closer to the junkyard than off the assembly line. There also was no guarantee that a newer car would work any better than this car was working currently. However, I remembered the demands of the life and ministry of a pastor, the reality of Wisconsin winters, and that I needed a reliable vehicle in order to take care of the people God has entrusted to my care. And so I decided to part with my Chevy Impala and to get a newer car, which turned out to be Fr. Burish's 2019 Honda CRV. It only had 60,000 miles on it and was well maintained. It was all-wheel drive and proven to be very reliable. It was going to serve the mission that God had given to me to be the pastor in Chippewa Falls much better.

Nevertheless, it was difficult to part with my old car. That car represented many good memories of nine years of serving God's people. It was a very good car and I enjoyed many things about it. I was surprised at how attached I had become to it and how hard it was to get used to my new car.

I think that our parishes here in the Chippewa Falls area, and in some way, the whole Diocese of La Crosse, are at a similar point. Here in Chippewa, we could have continued on with two pastors and two pastorates. It was working ok, however, we all know that with the current number of priests available in the near future, that it was not going to last forever, and the situation could change at any moment. This new arrangement of having one pastor for five parishes with a few associates to help, is like my new car. It seems like it will work, but there are no guarantees it will be "better" than past arrangements.

The mission to serve the people of God and proclaim the Gospel to all people requires stable

THIS & THAT: "GRIEF & ABUNDANCE" | In the Gospel today from Matthew 14:13-21, Jesus leaves the crowd and returns to Nazareth where he seeks some alone time. Jesus needed to rest and to grieve the death of his cousin John the Baptist who was killed by Herod. But the crowds follow Jesus (no rest for him). Jesus healed the sick until the end of the day when everyone was hungry. The disciples wanted to send the crowd away to get their own food. But instead of dismissing the crowd, Jesus tells the

disciples to feed the crowd. Five loaves and two fish wouldn't go very far with that big crowd. Jesus ordered the crowd to sit down on the grass, and he blessed and broke the loaves, gave them to the disciples, who gave them to the crowd – five thousand men, not counting the women and children. WOW! What an abundant meal, with twelve wicker baskets left over. Jesus modeled for us a compassion that reaches out to others, even when we would rather withdraw within ourselves and let the world go away. Jesus taught us that God blesses compassion offered to others with his grace. We share our abundance when we reach out to help at Agnes Table and Sojourner House. Thanks to those with generous hearts who give of their time and treasure so that others will be fed. Each of the four gospels has a story of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes. The story in today's Gospel is in anticipation of the Eucharist in which we are fed by the abundant grace of God. The importance of the Eucharist has been a defining element of Catholic Christian life from the beginning. Matthew's Gospel doesn't tell us if Jesus got some alone time to rest and grieve – hopefully, he did! Together, let us pray for a greater appreciation and love of the Eucharist. Communication from the Transition Team

In the next few months Fr. Sedlacek, the Leadership Team, & our parishes staff, are prayerfully discussing and slowly making decisions about 3 things.

- **Use of Buildings**
- **Staff Organization**
- **Daily Mass Schedule**

The Transition Team is giving consultation to Father and receiving input from parishioners.

1. One Parish Office: Leadership & staff are formulating a plan to combine all the parish offices under one roof at St. Charles Borromeo Rectory. This plan will take months to implement, and will likely have at least two phases. We will update you whenever there is a change.

2. Staff Organization: We are taking some weeks now to discern the best way to organize staff duties and the needs of all our parishes to best serve the parishes & the mission of our pastorate. We will continue to update you as it progresses. For now, we are pausing on hiring a replacement for Alexis Wislinsky,

who recently resigned as Director of Religious Education at St. Charles Borromeo and St. Peter.

3. Daily Mass Schedule: No updates this week.

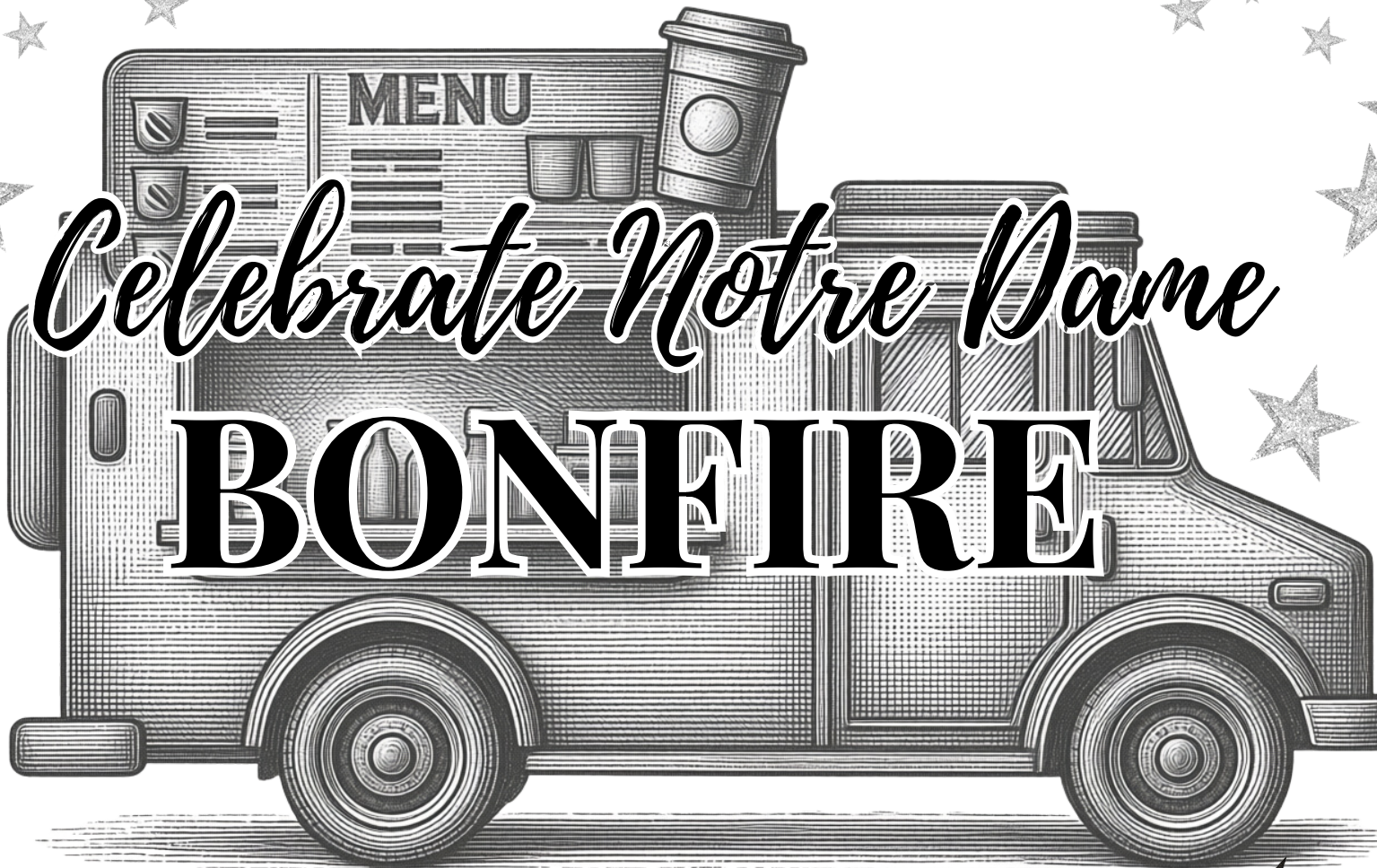
