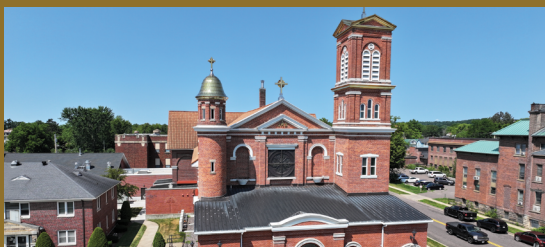

Peace to you! This coming weekend, on Saturday August 22nd, the Diocese of La Crosse is hosting their third and final Evangelization Summit for 2026 at one of our parishes, St. Charles Borromeo. Please check out the details for the Summit in this bulletin. It will begin with Mass at 8 AM at St. Charles and end at around 3 PM. I hope that you will be able to attend! You can sign up with the QR code or even the morning of the event at the door. There is a \$20 suggested donation to help defray the costs.

I have been to the two prior Summits which the Diocese has put together in the past several months and they were very worthwhile events. The themes have all been around Evangelization, that is, witnessing the Gospel to others and helping them to enter into the Church. The particular focus of the Summit here in Chippewa will be on the person of St. Peter and his encounters with Jesus that brought healing to his life and helped him to respond to Jesus' call to be an Apostle. The presentations are less about being talked at and more about doing and engaging. I am looking forward to it and am honored that we are able to host this event.

Evangelization is one of the hallmarks of our pastorate, Our Lady of the Falls. We are focused on making "missionary disciples" who can introduce people to Jesus Christ and accompany them into the life of His Church, where they can find healing, salvation, forgiveness, and purpose. When our parishes have worked together for evangelization, it has borne fruit. We see many people joining the Church, entering Christian Initiation, going deeper in their Faith via discipleship, bible studies, and supporting each other in true friendship, and we see our young people responding to God's call to enter seminary or go on mission. John Francis is a seminarian from Notre Dame who is starting his 2nd year of theology studies at St. Francis seminary. This year, Isaiah DeCook is beginning seminary with the propaedeutic program at Immaculate Heart of Mary seminary in Winona. Paige Smiskey, a recent college graduate and McDonell alumna, is beginning a two-year mission with FOCUS at Northwest Missouri State. Ben Siegenthaler, Ella Rubenzer, and Chiara Irwin, all McDonell grads, will be beginning a year with NET ministries working with young people in Scotland and all over the U.S. Please keep them in your prayers!

These young people and many other parishioners at Our Lady of the Falls inspire me. They are praying, listening for God's voice, and responding with generosity to be missionary disciples for Christ and His Church. It is one of the main reasons we are now working together as a 5-parish pastorate. Every parishioner has a part to play. This is an "all hands on deck" effort. Perhaps the Evangelization Summit or another offering is the next step for you?

THIS & THAT: "She wouldn't take 'no' for an answer!" Today's gospel from Matthew 15:21-28 presents us with an image of Jesus that we are not used to or comfortable with. A poor Canaanite woman asks Jesus for a favor, and he not only ignores her, but even seems to insult her. What was Jesus thinking? Was he: 1) testing her faith, 2) so preoccupied with his primary mission to the Jewish people that he couldn't deal with anything else, 3) reflecting cultural prejudice, 4) or just being playful? At this time, the Canaanites were a despised group. Naming the woman a Canaanite is part of Matthew's strategy. The cure of the woman's sick child is a response to her faith that Jesus called "great" and a reminder that salvation comes as a response to faith in Jesus. It is faith in God who desires to have mercy on all that unites us, and not any ethnic or national identity that makes us an insider in God's kingdom. Who are the marginalized within our faith communities and our towns? Who are being kept in their place? People who do not share our social networks tend

to be invisible or threatening to us. We might want to say with the disciples, "Send them away!" Yet we have the responsibility to see that everyone is offered a place at the table of the Lord. Many churches, including St. Bridget's, have an outside sign saying "ALL ARE WELCOME." Are there insiders and outsiders in our churches or are we united as a community of faith? Let us pray for each other, try not to be judgmental of those who are different, but welcoming to all. Have a blessed week & stay healthy! – Sr. Yvonne
