

#### St. Teresa of Los Andes

Feast Day: April 12 (1900-1920)

As a young girl growing up in Santiago, Chile, in the early 1900s, she read an autobiography of a French-born saint—Thérèse, popularly known as the Little Flower. The experience deepened her desire to serve God and clarified the path she would follow. At age 19 she became a Carmelite nun, taking the name of Teresa. The convent offered the simple lifestyle Teresa desired and the joy of living in a community of women completely devoted to God. She focused her days on prayer and sacrifice. "I am God's," she wrote in her diary. "He created me and is my beginning and my end." Toward the end of her short life, Teresa began an apostolate of letter-writing, sharing her thoughts on the spiritual life with many people. At age 20 she contracted typhus and quickly took her final vows. She died a short time later, during Holy Week. She is Chile's first saint.

#### From Fr. Jesse Burish



Praised be Jesus Christ! Happy Easter and Divine Mercy Sunday!

This Sunday is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. It is a special feast that was instituted by Pope St. John Paul II in the year 2000. The feast was declared in response a request made by the Lord Jesus in special revelations he had given to St. Faustina Kowalska, a nun in Krakow, Poland in the 1930s. The Lord revealed to Sister Faustina the message of his Divine Mercy. She kept a record of these revelations in notebooks that were compiled

and are now known as the *Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska*. The message of Divine Mercy revealed to St. Faustina could be summed up in this way: (taken from www.thedivinemercy.org)

- A) Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- B) Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.
- C) Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

Today, the Church offers a plenary indulgence (a full remission of temporal punishment due to sin to anyone who takes part in the Divine Mercy Devotion where it is celebrated in any church or chapel. The Divine Mercy celebration for our deanery is being celebrated this Sunday at Notre Dame from 1pm until about 3:15pm. Priests will be available for confessions throughout the afternoon. To obtain the plenary indulgence the Church offers on this feast, one must:

- · Be in a state of grace
- Be detached from every affection for sin, including venial sin
- Take part in prayers and devotions in honor of Divine Mercy in the presence of the Eucharist (exposed or in the tabernacle)
- · Recite the Our Father and the Creed
- · Add a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus

The general requirements for a plenary indulgence (confession, communion, prayers for the pope's intentions) can be fulfilled ahead of time or over time. Of course, to ensure that one is in a state of grace to fulfill the particular indulgence of Divine Mercy Sunday, it is most prudent to confess either that weekend or shortly before. However, provided the communicant is in a state of grace for Communion, sacramental confession can be received within twenty days either before or after Divine Mercy Sunday.

Here are a few other encouraged forms of Divine Mercy devotion:

- Praying before the Image of Divine Mercy The Lord Jesus revealed to St. Faustina that an image be
  made depicting Jesus dressed in white with one hand raised in blessing, and with two rays of light
  coming out from his chest, one red, the other clear, representing the Blood and Water representing
  Eucharist and Baptism, the sacraments that flow from his merciful heart.
- 2. Praying the Chaplet of Divine Mercy Prayed simply on Rosary beads. On the larger beads, one says, "Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world." On the ten smaller beads, we pray, "For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world." You pray five "decades" in this way, after which one prays three times, "Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world." This is a wonderful prayer to be prayed anytime, but especially near the time of someone's death, and for those hardened by sin.
- 3. Praying at Three in the Afternoon Invoke the mercy of Jesus, especially for sinners, at the hour he died on the cross. Reflect for a moment on Jesus' Passion and the abandonment he felt at his moment of agony.

#### THIS &THAT FROM SR. YVONNE

#### "SEEING IS BELIEVING"

In the early days after the Resurrection, Jesus appeared to his followers bringing them the Blessing of Peace. They were gathered behind locked doors, scared that the same guys who put Jesus on the Cross would come after them, too. John's Gospel 20:19-31. Tells us that Jesus came to bring the Holy Spirit. Now Thomas, often called "doubting Thomas" was not in the room that day. When the other disciples told him excitedly that they had seen the Lord, he could not believe and said that unless he could touch Jesus' wounds, he could not believe that Jesus had risen from the dead. Jesus gave him the time to come to faith, even offering to meet Thomas' requirement of touching his wounds and putting his hand into his side. We don't know if Thomas actually did this or not: but we do know that Thomas was moved in faith to say; "MY LORD AND MY GOD." Only when he was with the assembled believers did he come to faith in Jesus. The faith required of Thomas is, in a way, more demanding than that required of those who first encountered the risen Lord. We may judge Thomas harshly, but Jesus does not. Instead, Jesus invited Thomas to touch him, an invitation not extended earlier to the other disciples. Thomas then declares that the risen Lord is God in a profession of faith that we cherish even today. Many of us were taught to say to ourselves when the priest holds us the host and the chalice at the consecration: "MY LORD AND MY GOD." What does it mean for you to say that beautiful prayer? We should never forget the message Jesus gave to us after his resurrection. Basically, he said that it was up to us now and he gave us the Holy Spirit. "As the Father has sent me, so I send you" to carry out the mission of the church with the power to forgive sins. Let us pray for an increase of faith that we will not be tested beyond what we, with God's grace, can bear and that we persevere in faith. This Gospel from John is appropriate for Divine Mercy Sunday. In his great mercy, Jesus deeply desired that Thomas believe that he had truly risen. The gospels are filled with examples of Jesus' mercy, from his healing of people who were blind or sick. to giving food to the hungry etc. His greatest act of mercy was his self-offering on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins. Along with Thomas, we are all in need of his mercy and compassion. May our gathering together today help us experience his peace, recognize him in faith, unite us with him in love and deepen our love for one another. Let us live in the Holy Spirit's love, forgiveness and peace and pray that others may come to believe. May it be so! Many blessings during this wonderful Easter season, and don't forget the HAPPY WORD that we didn't sav all of Lent.
