## From Fr. Daniel Sedlacek

Peace to you! And a very blessed beginning of the Lenten season to you. This Sunday we send our catechumens and candidates from our parishes in the Chippewa Falls area to see the Bishop at the Rites of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion. "Candidates" are those who are baptized (either Protestant or Catholic) and want to be received into the Catholic Church and/or receive the sacraments of Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist. "Catechumens" are those who are preparing for baptism and the other two sacraments of Initiation

(Confirmation and Holy Eucharist). During Lent, let us continually lift up our prayers for our almost 40 candidates and catechumens who are preparing to receive the sacraments soon.

Please join me and the entire diocese with prayer and fasting this coming Friday, February 27th, which is our diocesan-wide "Day of Prayer and Penance for Diocesan and Universal Church Needs." This day was first established by the Fourth Diocesan Synod in 1986. On this day, members of the Diocese "offer their prayer, fasting, and almsgiving in reparation for their own sins and the sins of the world. . . . [We] turn our attention to our dependence on God, who alone fulfills our hungers and brings healing to a wounded world" (Catholic Household Blessings and Prayers, p.164).

We will continue praying our "Evangelization Prayer" after Mass during Lent, especially for the intention that our Catholic brothers and sisters who have fallen away would "come home," especially by receiving the sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. We will also adjust some of our practices at Sunday Mass to help us connect to God in a renewed way this Lent. For example, we will be ending Mass in silence, rather than having a closing hymn so that we can have some interior time with Jesus whom we have just received in the Eucharist before we are sent out to proclaim the Good News. There will be other times during Mass where there will be more silence than usual so that we have the opportunity to open our hearts to God and better learn how to listen for His voice. We will also be foregoing the sign of peace, not to be unfriendly, but so that we may better focus on the peace that is coming from Christ who is present on the altar. I will be writing more in the future about the sign of peace and the beautiful tradition of this sign in the Roman Rite. My hope is that when we begin to offer the sign of peace again during Eastertime, it will be both more meaningful and grace-filled. A blessed Lent to you all! – Fr. Sedlacek

**THIS & THAT — "Jesus' temptations: My temptations"** | On this first Sunday in Lent, Matthew 4:1-11 tells us that Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit into the desert where he prepared for his ministry. Before important events in his life, Jesus was in touch with his Father in heaven. Jesus was about to begin his mission of teaching, healing and driving out demons. The devil was trying to convince Jesus that he should use the special powers for his own benefit. The devil is trying to use the lure of power to divert Jesus from the work assigned him by his Father. Jesus' response is that of an obedient Son: "The Lord your God shall you worship and him alone shall you serve." While we might be tempted to turn away from God, no power can force us to do anything against our will no matter how severely we are tempted. Temptation is something we give in to. Jesus refused to cooperate with the devil to achieve status and power. We ask for help so that we can refuse to cooperate with evil and injustice in achieving our life's goals. Our sins are our responsibility, and we can't say "the devil made me do it" as we used to hear in an old Flip Wilson show. Together let us pray that this Lent will be a time of deeper

understanding of what it means to be God's beloved child. We can make a Lenten resolution and each day ask God to help us keep it. We need to be grateful that we have Jesus to help us resist temptation, and to walk with us on this Lenten journey as we look forward to the joys of Easter. Happy Lent! Keep healthy as we look forward to the coming of spring and the joys of Easter. Let us pray for each other and for world peace – Sr. Yvonne

**Two Lenten Regulations:**

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18. Lenten regulations are as follows:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 60th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
