From Fr. David Nowicki

Dear brothers & sisters, Happy eighth day of Easter, or Divine Mercy Sunday as we more likely know it. I've considered Divine Mercy to seem out-of-place in the liturgical year on first inspection. When we think of mercy, we often think of confession, and confession is often associated with Lent.

Then why on earth is Divine Mercy Sunday celebrated on the eighth day of Easter? Because even the Resurrection happened on account of God's mercy.

At times our redemption looked like a "mission impossible". None of us could ever earn our own salvation, leaving us at a catch-22. How could I get back to God if I'm incapable of returning to God on account of my sin, suffering, and limitations?

God was the only one able to do anything about this crisis of humanity, and He didn't have to do anything about it. The sending of Jesus was entirely out of the Lord's mercy for us, even in our brokenness. And yet, even in the lifetime of Jesus, some people still saw God's plan as a "mission impossible". *How is this going to work? What will Jesus do to save us? Who could possibly be saved?* In response to these queries, Jesus simply asked for our trust, saying, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

The Apostles certainly trusted in Jesus – but even their trust in God's plan was tested at the Crucifixion. Eventually they despaired at this "mission impossible", fleeing Christ precisely at the moment when he undertook the mission in its fullness.

And then He succeeded.

While undergoing death was necessary, it would be pointless if Jesus hadn't risen from the dead. Otherwise, we would still be without concrete hope in our resurrection and the life of the world to come. Because of the resurrection, we who were lost in sin could finally return to His Father and our Father.

The octave of Easter is a celebration of "mission impossible" becoming "mission accomplished". All because God loved us even while we were sinners – which is mercy. Divine Mercy, even. That's definitely worth celebrating on the eighth day of Easter.

THIS & THAT — "MY LORD AND MY GOD!" | The story of Thomas in today's gospel illustrates our Christian experience of today. We are often called to believe without seeing. Thomas's doubt is hardly surprising because he wanted evidence that the Jesus who appeared to the disciples after his death was the same Jesus who had been crucified. A week later Jesus appeared to the disciples again and Thomas was with them. Jesus gives Thomas the opportunity to act on his desire. We don't know if Thomas actually touched Jesus but we hear Thomas had a greater level of faith when he declared: "MY LORD AND MY GOD!"

Pope John Paul II in 2000 designated today as Divine Mercy Sunday.

Faith is a gift that we have been given. Through Baptism we receive the same Holy Spirit that Jesus brought to the first disciples. God's mercy is not limited to this one Sunday of the year. God is ready to forgive us any time we approach

him with true sorrow for our sins. Our response to the goodness of God in our life can be the same as that of Thomas exclaiming: "MY LORD AND MY GOD!" Thomas is a witness that Jesus is really risen. Let us pray for each other that we might have a greater mercy for those who may not believe based on our word.
