From Fr. David Nowicki

One hundred thirty five years ago this week, Fr. Charles Francis Xavier Goldsmith took his last breath at the age of forty-four. His was a life of frenetic activity: under his leadership, the present church was constructed, the Catholic hospital was founded, the parish school was founded with the help of the School Sisters of Notre Dame (of whom we have benefitted from the vocation of Sr. Yvonne, among others), and Holy Ghost was established as one of twelve daughter churches of Notre Dame Parish, among many other accomplishments. Fr. Goldsmith lived his life as though we were to die tomorrow, but he did

his work so that he "may tell the next generation that such is our God, our God forever and always." (Ps. 48:13-14).

To that end, Fr. Goldsmith's final request was a memorial chapel where he could be buried. Far from a self-promoting action, this chapel was to remind those who come after him of God's goodness in spite of our finitude — a fitting reminder for the month of November in remembrance of All Souls. This chapel is what we currently use as the adoration chapel where, in the crypt below the altar, one can pray at the tomb of this remarkable man. It's an arresting thought that the same place that exists as a memento of our death now shelters the Bread of Life.

This end of the liturgical year is also a reminder of the sights we as Christians are to fix our eyes upon: the King of Kings will return to take His throne and rule over all heaven and earth. We are called to be the caretakers and stewards of that kingdom. While we constantly try to usurp the throne by our sin, time and again we find ourselves incapable of assuming the crown that is rightly Christ's. We absolutely need the King to return in our lives when we kick Him out in rebellion. This was why Fr. Goldsmith lived his life the way he did: all for the glory of the true King. This week, take some time to visit that king in the adoration chapel, and while you're there, stop downstairs and pray for Fr. Goldsmith at his tomb, with the hope that one day he, you, and I can rejoice in the return of the King to restore all things in Himself.

THIS & THAT — "CHRIST THE KING AND THANKSGIVING" | This is the last Sunday of the Church year when we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King followed by Thanksgiving at the end of the week. Luke's Gospel has been loaded with surprises: the poor are rich, sinners find salvation, and the Kingdom of God is found in our midst. In today's Gospel from Luke 23:35-43 we see the greatest surprise of all. We see the crucified Jesus whom faith tells us is King and Savior of us all. The inscription placed on the cross contains a profound truth that read: "This is the King of the Jews." The leaders at the time jeer, but the thief crucified at his side recognizes Jesus as Messiah and King and finds salvation. Jesus says to him: "Today you will be with me in paradise." Jesus is not the kind of king we might

have imagined, but those who had their eyes of faith were able to see who Jesus was. Today's gospel invites us to make our own judgment and to recognize Jesus as King and Savor of all. We might sing the words of the song using the words of the good thief: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." We give thanks for God's many blessings to us. As part of the faith community of Our Lady of the Falls Catholic Community, we are thankful for all those who step forward in leadership, those who share their time and talent teaching and inviting people to follow Jesus. 


