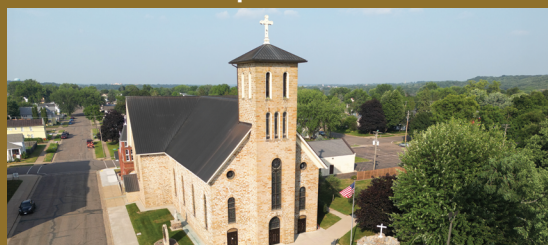

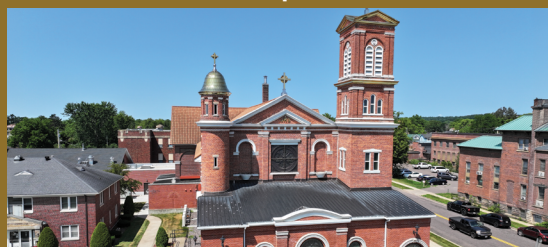

Peace to you! Next week will introduce a significant change in the life of Catholics in the Our Lady of the Falls pastorate. Starting Monday, August 17th, there will be a new schedule of weekday Masses at our parishes, schools, and nursing homes. This new schedule has been put together with consultation of the priest team, the pastorate leadership team, the transition team, and the staff of the various entities affected: Four of our 5 parishes (*Notre Dame, Holy Ghost, St. Charles, St. Peter*), 5 schools (*St. Peter, Holy Ghost, St. Charles, McDonell High School, Regis High School*), and five Nursing Homes. Note: The weekend/Sunday Mass times are not affected by this change.

Some of you may wonder, "Why is the daily Mass schedule changing?" Here are some of the main reasons. *First*, we have one less priest available. Fr. Nowicki became the Chaplain of Regis High and Middle Schools in Eau Claire. The Masses that were covered last year by five priests are now only being covered by four. In other terms, the current schedule with our assignments had 21 or 22 regularly scheduled Monday-Saturday daily Masses done by five priests (the four in Chippewa Falls and Fr. Levi Schmitt, the previous chaplain at Regis). It would be incredibly difficult for the four priests to cover these consistently, especially if one or two priests are out of town that day. In addition to 12 weekend Masses being offered by the 4 Chippewa priests, there have been a lot of Masses offered relative to the number of people who attend.

Second, we were having and will continue to have the following issues if we don't change:

A) Whenever a priest was out of town on a weekday, we were regularly, at least a few times per month, cancelling scheduled Masses. This caused communication burdens on our staff, disruption to the Mass schedule, and a sense of uncertainty about the Mass schedule. "Is there going to be an 8am Mass at ND this morning... or was it canceled because a priest is out of town?"

B) Funeral Masses. We have about 70 funerals every year in our pastorate. Whenever there was a funeral, there was inevitably at least one priest taking two

Masses on those days. This may not seem like a big deal, but when a priest is offering multiple Mass most days of the week, it is not good. Canon Law regulates that priests should *normally* only have one Mass per day, and there are good reasons for that!

C) Wedding Masses. These have seemingly been increasing in number, praise God! However, this means another liturgy our priests get to do. These usually occur on Saturday, but increasingly also on Friday afternoons or evenings.

THIS & THAT: "*Jesus says, 'COME.'"* In last Sunday's Gospel we learned that Jesus had just heard about the death of his cousin, John the Baptist, who was killed by Herod. We learn that Jesus postponed his time of solitude and prayer, but instead healed the sick and fed the people. In the Gospel today, Matthew 14:22-33, Jesus sends his disciples ahead of him by boat, dismisses the crowds, and then goes to the mountain to pray. At three in the morning, Jesus finds the disciples being tossed about in the boat, afraid of drowning. Jesus comes to them, walking on the water. The disciples think they were seeing a ghost. Jesus tells them not to be afraid and to take courage. Peter, who always seems to say the right thing by saying the wrong thing at the right time, calls out to Jesus saying: "Lord, if it is really you, tell me to come to you across the water." Jesus calls back to Peter and says: "**COME.**" Peter walks on the water,

and then he begins to sink. When Peter is focused on Jesus, everything is fine. When Peter takes his eyes off Jesus, noticing the fierce wind, then he begins to sink. What made him sink? When we, like Peter, trust our fear, we too will sink. The gift of faith can work unexpected wonders in our lives. If we begin to doubt or fear, all we need to do is reach out for Jesus' outstretched hand. When we step out in faith, we may have to leave some old ways of life behind. From Peter we can learn to keep focused on Jesus even when things get scary and difficult. Consider people you know whose faith is being challenged. In what ways could you be the extended arm of Jesus to them? Father's Column (Cont.)

A new schedule had to accommodate four priests to do what five priests used to do. We now have those four priests covering 14 **regularly scheduled** daily Masses. This new schedule helps avoid Problem A almost all the time. Even if one priest is unavailable on any given day, we rarely will have to cancel daily Masses. There are many positives in this. Also, there is now greater flexibility with scheduling funeral & wedding Masses. Perhaps even 2 funeral Masses in one day in the rare, but very possible event.

Once we started to tweak the schedule, there was a domino effect. And so, in putting together the new schedule with a lot of changes, we had to set priorities. In the Rebuild My Church listening sessions last Fall, people in our pastorate cited that the number one loss that they experienced was "family members leaving the Faith." The number one fear is "declining Mass attendance and membership, especially for younger people." The number one hope and desire is "for our parishes to experience growth in young people and young families becoming more active in parish life." And so, we wanted to offer a few new daily Mass times each week that would potentially foster the spiritual life of our younger members: 1) A couple Mass times that people could attend before work or school. 2) An evening Mass time on Wednesday, the one evening where there are no school sporting events and practices. 3) School Masses for each school. The new 8am Mass times and locations are where they are for the sake of the school children. And so, the first priority in our new daily Mass schedule is that our children and families with children at home have a Mass time available to them at least once every week, if not more often.

What I hope we will experience with this new Mass schedule are fuller daily Masses and community building across our parishes, increased daily Mass availability for folks with work and school schedules, a more flexible load for our priests so that we can offer better care for the people of our parishes, schools, and elderly, and focus on growing the Faith, especially in our younger people. Please take note of the changes in times and locations of our daily Masses as listed this bulletin that will take effect on Monday, Aug. 17 and form a plan to make daily Mass a part of your spiritual life.
