## From Fr. David Nowicki

Last weekend I had the opportunity that few people get to have: my dad was ordained a deacon on Saturday and preached his first homily on Sunday.

On Saturday I watched Bishop Battersby ordain my father and five other men to the order of the diaconate for the Diocese of La Crosse. During the ordination liturgy, the newly ordained men have another deacon or a priest vest them with the liturgical vestments proper to the deacon for the first time. My dad chose me to vest him in the deacon's stole and the dalmatic. It was a blessing and an honor to welcome my dad to the order of the diaconate and to serve the Church alongside him.

Then on Sunday I returned to St. Anthony in Athens, the parish of my childhood, to celebrate Mass with my dad as deacon. First homilies can always be daunting, and most deacons I know tend to be nervous about preaching publicly for the first time. "Deacon Dad" did a great job, preaching about the importance of the Most Holy Eucharist.

The experience reminded me of two things. First, I recalled my own ordination as a deacon almost three years ago. Every priest is also a deacon, and so every priest has received the very grave the six men received on Saturday. What a gift!

Secondly, gratitude welled up in me for the men who have answered the call to serve Christ and His Church in the diaconate. We have three deacons in the city of Chippewa Falls, and their service to the Church, both liturgically and pastorally, is immensely valuable.

I wish to make two invitations: firstly, for any men who have ever asked themselves how God is calling them to serve the Church, please pray about whether God is calling you to become a deacon. It is a beautiful vocation, even within the larger vocation of marriage! Second, please take a moment to thank our

**THIS & THAT: "If we don't help, it won't get done"** In the gospel from Matthew 9: 36-10:8, Jesus sends the 12 apostles to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. Jesus tells them that "the harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few." Christ's mission is not someone else's job—it needs all of us. If we don't help, it won't get done. In the gospel the disciples are sent to continue doing the work that Jesus has begun. The focus has shifted from the ministry of Jesus to the work of the community that Jesus has inaugurated. More than any other gospel, Matthew elaborates on the work of the Church, which is to continue after his death and resurrection. As Jesus sent his disciples to continue his work and mission, we know that the Church is his continuing presence on earth. Every member of the Church (that's us folks) is sent by Jesus to contribute to the mission. This task can seem daunting, yet when we learn to work with others to achieve a common goal, we have learned something of what it means to do the work of Christ. The family is one place in which we work with others, sharing

a common task and a common goal. Being part of our faith community in the Chippewa Valley, we, too, are sent to proclaim the kingdom of heaven. We don't have to be a priest or a sister, nor do we have to go to a faraway land to do this. In bringing Jesus's love to others, we have to be willing to say the difficult thing, and sometimes the comforting thing, but always saying what will bring healing and give life. "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." Let us pray for each other as we do our part to bring about God's kingdom. **If we don't help, it won't get done.** Have a blessed week and stay healthy! – Sr. Yvonne
